Dear Parents/Carers

At Burlington Infant & Nursery school we aim to provide pupils with a full and enriched education by offering activities which often fall outside of the national curriculum.

These activities include workshops and events such as Earthsong drumming, Don Rae Dance, The Space Dome, "Pretend Holiday" days, art workshops and Healthy Living Week Big Breakfasts.

In light of the above, we ask parents/carers to make a small voluntary contribution towards the School Fund in order to help to enrich the quality of our pupils' education during their time at the school.

The voluntary contribution for Burlington Infant & Nursery School is £40 per family, although you are welcome to give more, of course. This is separate to the contribution made to the Junior school. These contributions allow us to maintain a high and varied standard of education, however, we would like to make it clear that this contribution is entirely voluntary and we are grateful for any support that you can give.

The way in which the funds are spent will be decided upon based on requests from teaching staff and children.

Please make your donation via your School Gateway account. You can make a one-off payment of £40 (please note that School Gateway allocates the amount to each child therefore if you have more than one child at the school, you only need to make one payment against one child). There is also an option to pay on a reducing balance with smaller instalments throughout the year. If you need any assistance with School Gateway or are having problems activating your account, please speak to the school office.
