

Speech and Language Therapy for children in schools Information for Parents/carers

How is Speech and Language Therapy provided in Mainstream schools?

Each primary school has an allocated Speech and Language Therapist who works with the School SENCO/Inclusion Leader to support children with identified speech, language and communication needs.



- We work closely with the school to help staff identify children who have speech, language or communication difficulties.
- We offer support and advice to school on ways to help children with language and communication difficulties.
- We support the school to set up language and communication groups.

Sometimes schools need more specific help with a child's communication needs. They will share their concerns with you. If this happens, you will be given information about the Speech and Language Therapy Service and asked to provide information regarding your child's needs.
