How we spend our time in Acorns



At Acorns, we plan fun and exciting activities which the children can engage in each day. Activities are planned around children's interests and ideas, stories and special themes and events such as Book Week, Fathers' day, cultural and religious festivals. Children choose the activities they want to participate in, as well as being able to self-select arts and crafts, games and puzzles available every day.

Here are some of the activities they have enjoyed this term:

Active Play



We ensure children have access to outside play and get plenty of exercise and fresh air every day before and after their meal time. There are a range of outdoor play equipment for the children to select, as well as adult-organised games such as circle games and football matches.









Collaborative Play



We are proud of the way our children play collaboratively together, helping and learning from each other. Important play skills such as negotiation, social skills, leadership and turn taking are nurtured by supportive adults. Children make new friends outside of their own class, in a smaller social environment at Acorns.





Creative Play



There are many opportunities for arts and crafts at Acorns. This includes themed and adult led activities such as cooking and jewellery making, as well as self-chosen and child-led activities such as junk modelling, drawing and painting. Children build confidence in developing their creative skills in a relaxed atmosphere.









Outdoor Play



At Burlington, we value the importance of outdoor play, and this continues at Acorns. Children have the freedom to explore our large outdoor areas, which includes our wonderful orchard, where Acorns children have built bug hotels and looked for bugs.
