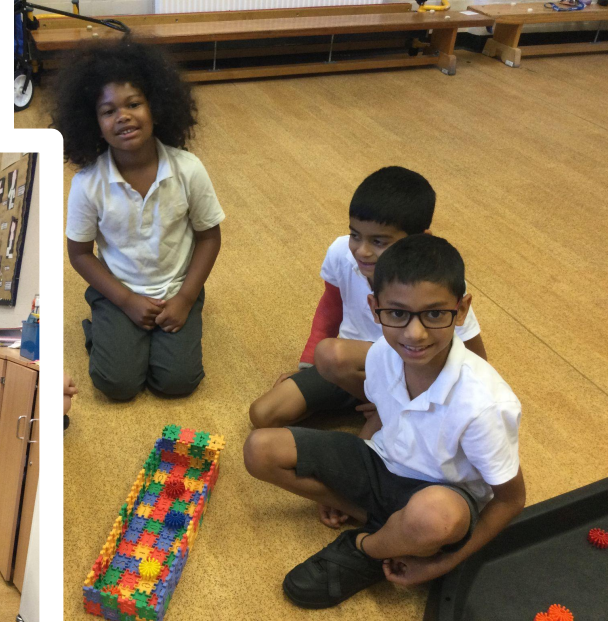
# Indoor Play

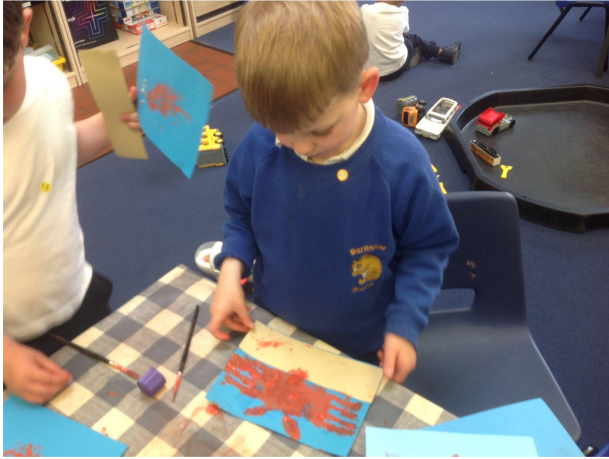
