Dance Dots - Reception children only

When: Monday 3.30 - 4.15pm

Where: Great Hall

Dates: 27th February - 27th March

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 5 sessions - £30.00

A party in every class! Your Dance Dot can strut their stuff to their favourite music and a few oldies thrown in too! Classes start with a warm up followed by simple dance routines of different genres i.e. street, jazz, ballet, cheerleading, Bollywood etc. and fun specialised dance games.
