Chess develops vision, independence, strategic power, a sense of responsibility, and accuracy in calculation, and in addition, it can be played and enjoyed by children as young as five!



Chess club welcomes complete beginners to more advanced players, all the children will be learning chess openings and check mates. In order to improve your child's chess skills I would recommend they try and play three games of chess a week. I would also advise purchasing a tournament chess mat and pieces and a digital chess clock.
