### **After School Clubs – 1st half of the Autumn Term**

Please find below details of the after school clubs we will be running in the 1st half of the Autumn Term.

If you would like to book a place for your child **please email [admin@burlingtoni.org.uk](mailto:admin@burlingtoni.org.uk) with your child's name, class and 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> choice of club. Please also provide a password for your child. (Please note that all children attending clubs need a password). We will be accepting emails from **Monday 11<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER at 8pm in the evening. Any emails received before this time will not be valid.** Once we have confirmed your place, you will be able to pay **online via School Gateway**, please ensure you have activated your account. If you have not been able to activate your School Gateway account, please speak to the school office. We try to ensure that children get a chance to take part in a club at least once a term so going forward from the second half of the autumn term, spaces will not be allocated on a first come first served basis and instead we will prioritise children who didn't get a place the previous half term.**

#### **Basketball - Year 1 & Year 2 children only**

**When:** Tuesday 3.30 - 4.15pm

**Where:** Infant Playground

**Dates:** 19th September - 17th October

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 5 sessions - FREE

*A fun and energetic class where children will learn basic basketball skills and techniques - running, jumping and handling the ball as well as developing the children's coordination and teamwork skills. As this club takes place outside, children will need to wear warm clothes including long tracksuit bottoms and sturdy trainers plus a waterproof jacket. The class is run by Mrs Feldwick who is the PE teacher at Burlington Infants.*

#### **Choir - Year 2 children only**

**When:** Thursday 3.30 - 4.15pm

**Where:** Infant Library

**Start Date:** 21st September

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** Ongoing - FREE

**(Children who sign up for choir will continue to be a choir member for the whole academic year. Spaces are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis and we will operate a waiting list system should anyone cancel their place throughout the year).**

*In choir we will have fun singing a range of songs, from fun game songs to performance pieces. Choir sessions will include singing, games and even percussion instruments! Children will also have the opportunity to perform at the Rose Theatre and PTA events. The choir is led by Mrs Williamson who is the music teacher at Burlington Infants.*

#### **Boomwhacker Music Club - Year 2 children only**

**When:** Wednesday 3.30 - 4.15pm

**Where:** Jupiter Class

**Dates:** 20th September - 6th December

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 9 sessions - FREE

*Boomwhackers are percussion instruments that are coloured plastic tubes of different lengths which produce musical tones. (Picture below) Children will already be familiar with them from their music lessons. In this club, children will have fun practising their technique and working towards a performance piece. The club will be run by our music teacher Mrs Williamson.*



**Bat & Ball – Year 1 and Year 2 children only**

**When:** Thursday 3.30 - 4.30pm

**Where:** Infant Playground

**Dates:** 21st September - 12th October

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 4 sessions - £28.00 (No class on 19th Oct due to early closure for parent consultations)

*The multisports club encourages the development of hand-eye co-ordination, balance and quick response through practising various sports such as bat and ball, basketball, tennis, rounders. Each coaching session will consist of a good warm up, and then learning the core skills that will help pupils to become more confident with their hand eye co-ordination. These coaching sessions are designed to be fun, educational and enjoyable with maximum participation for both boys and girls with all abilities catered for. This club will be run by Just4Kicks. As this club takes place outside, children will need to wear warm clothes including long tracksuit bottoms and sturdy trainers plus a waterproof jacket.*
