### **After School Clubs – 2nd half of the Spring Term**

Please find below details of the after school clubs we will be running in the 2nd half of the Spring Term.

Please also provide a password for your child. (Please note that **all** children attending clubs need a password). We will be accepting emails from **THURSDAY 1<sup>st</sup> FEBRUARY at 8pm in the evening. Any emails received before this time will not be valid.** Once we have confirmed your place, you will be able to pay **online via School Gateway**, please ensure you have activated your account. If you have not been able to activate your School Gateway account, please speak to the school office.**

***We try to ensure that children get a chance to take part in a club at least once a term, therefore spaces will not be allocated on a first come first served basis and instead we will prioritise children who didn't get a place the previous half term.***

#### **Dance Dots - Reception children only**

**When:** Monday 3.30 - 4.15pm

**Where:** Infant Hall

**Dates:** 26th February - 25th March

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 5 sessions - £30.00

*A party in every class! Your Dance Dot can strut their stuff to their favourite music and a few oldies thrown in too! Classes start with a warm up followed by simple dance routines of different genres i.e. street, jazz, ballet, cheerleading, Bollywood etc. and fun specialised dance games. The class is taken by Ms Walker who is a fully qualified dance teacher with the International Dance Teachers Association.*

#### **Basketball - Year 1 & Year 2 children only**

**When:** Tuesday 3.30 - 4.15pm

**Where:** Infant Playground

**Dates:** 27th February - 26th March

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 5 sessions - FREE

*A fun and energetic class where children will learn basic basketball skills and techniques - running, jumping and handling the ball as well as developing the children's coordination and teamwork skills. As this club takes place outside, children will need to wear warm clothes including long tracksuit bottoms and sturdy trainers plus a waterproof jacket. The class is run by Mrs Feldwick who is the PE teacher at Burlington Infants.*

#### **Multiskills Sports Club - Reception children only**

**When:** Wednesday 3.30 - 4.15pm

**Where:** Infant Playground

**Dates:** 28th February - 27th March

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 5 sessions - FREE

*A fun and high energy class to develop and encourage children's love of sport through a variety of activities and games, including ball skills, athletics, tennis etc. As this club takes place outside, children will need to wear*

warm clothes including long tracksuit bottoms and sturdy trainers plus a waterproof jacket. The class is run by Mrs Feldwick who is the PE teacher at Burlington Infants.

**Techno Club - Year 1 & Year 2 children only**

**When:** Tuesday LUNCHTIME

**Where:** Rubies Class

**Dates:** 27th February - 26th March

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 5 sessions - FREE

*Children will learn basic coding skills as well as digital art and literacy skills to increase their confidence in understanding and creating technology! The club will be run by Mr Johnson, one of our year 1 teachers.*

**Dates:** 26th February - 25th March

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 5 sessions - £15.00

*A fun-filled, hands-on cooking club where children will make easy recipes to take home each week while learning some basic culinary skills! This club will be run by Mrs McEvoy.*

**Sewing Club - Year 1 & Year 2 children only**

**When:** Tuesday 3.30 - 4.15pm

**Where:** Diamonds Class

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 4 sessions - £12.00

*Children will learn basic sewing skills in a fun and relaxed environment working towards a simple project which they will complete over the 4 weeks to take home at the end. This club will be run by Miss Moore, one of our year 1 teachers.*

**No of Sessions & Total Cost:** 4 sessions - £28.00

*The multisports club encourages the development of hand-eye co-ordination, balance and quick response through practising various sports such as bat and ball, basketball, tennis, rounders. Each coaching session will consist of a good warm up, and then learning the core skills that will help pupils to become more confident with their hand eye co-ordination. These coaching sessions are designed to be fun, educational and enjoyable with maximum participation for both boys and girls with all abilities catered for. This club will be run by Just4Kicks.
