Please find below details of the after school clubs we will be running in the 2nd half of the Summer Term.

We will be accepting bookings from WEDNESDAY 20TH MAY at 8pm in the evening. Once we have confirmed your place, you will be able to pay **online via School Gateway**, please ensure you have activated your account. If you have not been able to activate your School Gateway account, please speak to the school office.

We try to ensure that children get a chance to take part in a club at least once a term. Spaces will not be allocated on a first come first served basis and instead we will prioritise children who didn't get a place the previous half term.

Multiskills Lunchtime Club - Reception, Y1 & Y2 children

When: Monday 12.30-1.00pm (children will eat their lunch before the club)

Where: Infant MUGA

Dates: 15th June - 6th July

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 4 sessions - £24

Get active, build confidence, and have tons of fun! Each session consists of outdoor games and activities that develop balance, coordination, teamwork, and movement skills. From running and jumping to throwing and catching, every week offers something new! This club will be run by Ms Miriam who is one of our lunchtime supervisors and a qualified basketball coach.

Year 1 Art Club - Year 1 children only

When: Tuesday 3.30 - 4.15pm

Dates: 9th June - 7th July

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 5 sessions - £25

Come and explore the magical world of art! Try out new mediums, learn new skills and master new techniques each week. Projects will focus on various festivals we will be celebrating in school. Children will have the opportunity to create their own art pieces to take home at the end. The club will be run by Miss Braithwaite, Emeralds class teacher.

Year 2 Art Explorers - Year 2 children only

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 5 sessions - £35 (includes all materials)

Come and have fun with art! Each week we will explore different ways to create pictures and patterns using paint, pastels, chalks and pens, as well as cutting and pasting to make collages and making models out of paper and card. You will be able to take home your creations after each session.

Dance Dots - Reception children only

Dates: 8th June - 6th July

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 5 sessions - £35

A party in every class! Your Dance Dot can strut their stuff to their favourite music and a few oldies thrown in too! Classes start with a warm up followed by simple dance routines of different genres i.e. street, jazz, ballet, cheerleading, Bollywood etc. and fun specialised dance games. The class is taken by Ms Walker who is a fully qualified dance teacher with the International Dance Teachers Association.

Street/Freestyle Dance - Year 1 and Year 2 children only

Dates: 12th June - 3rd July (There will be no class on 10th July)

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 4 sessions - £28

A highly energetic dance subject and a great way to express your own style to upbeat music and rhythms. This class will involve a fusion of different body movements and follows the modern trends of pop music and street dance. This class will be run by Ms Walker who is a fully qualified IDTA dance teacher.

Basketball - Year 1 and Year 2 children only

Mini Hoopers - Reception children only

Dates: 15th June - 6th July

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 4 sessions - £28

A fun club that will get your children moving, learning, and having fun! Mini Hoopers is an introduction to basketball focusing on teamwork, coordination, and confidence through exciting games and simple skill-building activities. This club will be run by Ms Miriam who is one of our lunchtime supervisors and a qualified basketball coach.

Cricket – Year 1 and Year 2 children only

When: Thursday 3.30 - 4.30pm

Where: Infant Playground

Dates: 11th June - 9th July

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 5 sessions - £37.50

A fun class for children to learn basic cricket skills such as throwing, catching, batting and bowling whilst encouraging teamwork and developing fine and gross motor control. Each coaching session will consist of a good warm up, and then learning the core skills that will help pupils to become more confident with their hand eye co-ordination. These coaching sessions are designed to be fun, educational and enjoyable with maximum participation for both boys and girls with all abilities catered for. This club will be run by Just4Kicks. As this club takes place outside, children will need to wear warm clothes including long tracksuit bottoms and sturdy trainers plus a waterproof jacket.

No of Sessions & Total Cost: 5 sessions - £37.50
