



<u>Keep Active</u>

You are now experts at following Joe Wick's workouts. Can you create your own workout? Maybe ask an adult or brother or sister to join in.

Create a dance to your favourite piece of music. Make a poster advertising the time and date of your performance.

Create a circuit training workout.

Investigate different ways to make your heart beat faster. Which activity did you like the best?

We need to make sure we do not go out of the house too often but we are allowed to leave the house to do a little bit of exercise . If you decide to go on a walk can you look out for different things? Pick one of these ideas:

- Look for 5 signs of spring.
- Count the rainbows displayed in people's windows.
- Collect 5 different leaves. When you get home, research the name of the tree they come from. Or if you prefer something arty use some crayons and create a leaf rubbing picture.
- Find items for every colour of the rainbow. Can you find any more colours? (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, indigo, violet)
- Look for teddy bears in the windows of the houses you pass.

If you do go out, make sure you only walk with your family and you stay at least 2 metres away from anyone you pass on the street.

House Scavenger Hunt.

Collect all of the following items in a bag or basket.
A toy with wheels
A book with the first letter of your name in the title
A pair of matching sock
4 things that are green
Something very soft
A toy smaller than your hand
Something round
A book with numbers in it
A photo/picture of someone you love
A toy that has 3 different colours
Your snuggliest stuffed animal
Make a scavenger hunt for someone in your family.



Can you hide some treasure and write clues to find it? You could make the clues really tricky! Maybe a grown up or brother or sister could create a treasure hunt for you.





<u>Acts of Kindness</u>

Make a log of all the different acts of kindness you perform each day:

- Help a grownup prepare a meal
- Collect the plates and dishes after a meal and take them to the kitchen
- Tidy a room
- Weed the garden for 10 mins
- Make a poster to say thank you to the people working hard eg, NHS, postperson, shop workers, refuse collectors
- Read a book to a sibling

Make sure you also log how people have been kind to you each day too!

<u>Be creative</u>

Can you be an inventor? Design a brand new invention that will blow people's minds. Think of something that will change people's lives!



Create a super hero. What do they wear? What superpowers do they have? Do they have special gadgets that help them fight evil? Who are the evil baddies they have to defeat?

Junk Modelling: reuse empty packages and make different things.

<u>Word Fun:</u> How many words can you make using the letters from these words - remember you can only use these letters! **EASTER HOLIDAYS**. Can you beat my score of 10?

<u>Learn a new skill</u>

Is there something you've always wanted to do?:

E.g, Load the dishwasher. Tie your shoelaces. Lay the table. Follow a recipe.
