

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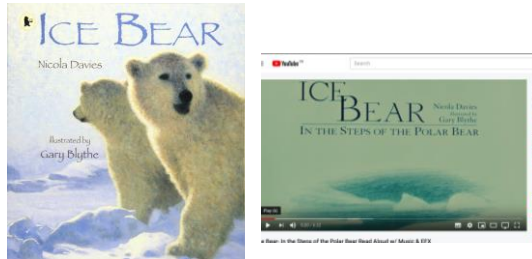
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**Writing:** This term we are learning about Bears. Mrs. Docwra is wondering if a Polar Bear would be a good animal to choose for

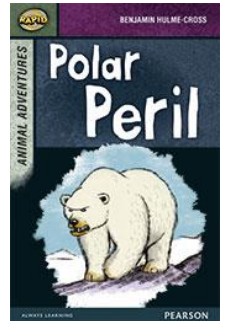

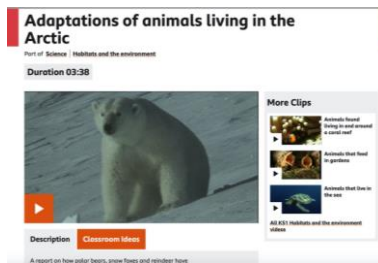

## Polar Bear

Polar bears are the largest carnivores (meat eaters) that live on land.

Polar bears use the Arctic sea ice to hunt seals.

Seals make up most of a polar bear's diet.

They have black skin and although their fur appears white, it is actually see through!

They have a layer of blubber beneath their skin to keep them warm.

Young polar bears, called cubs, are born between November and January while their mothers are hibernating in a den.



## Polar Bear

Polar bears have a great sense of smell and can smell seals from almost 1 km away and under 1 metre of snow.



A polar bear weighs between 175 - 650kg and measures approximately 2 - 3m.

Polar bears need to hunt earlier each year due to climate change which is melting the sea ice. This means their feeding season is shorter giving them less time in which to build up their fat reserves.

### Did You Know?

A polar bear's paws prevent them from breaking through the ice and snow.





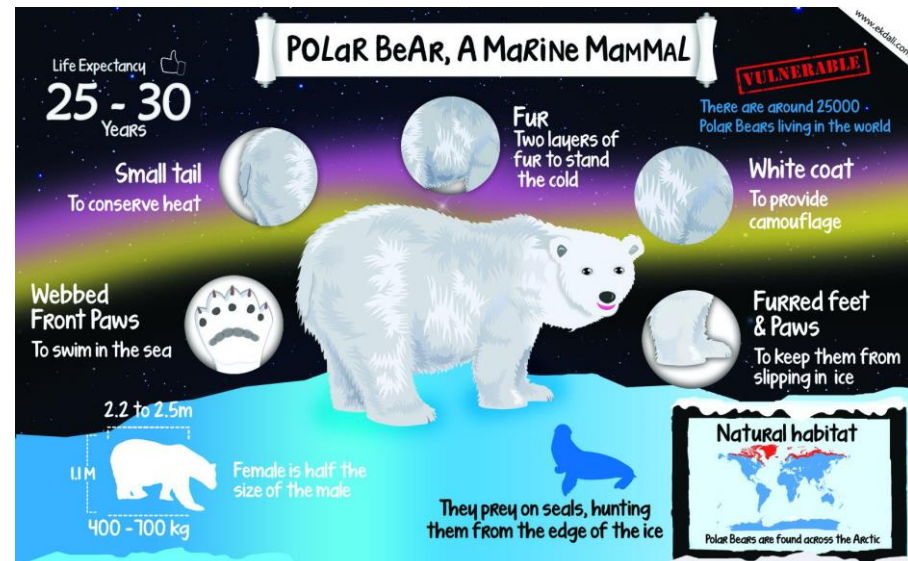
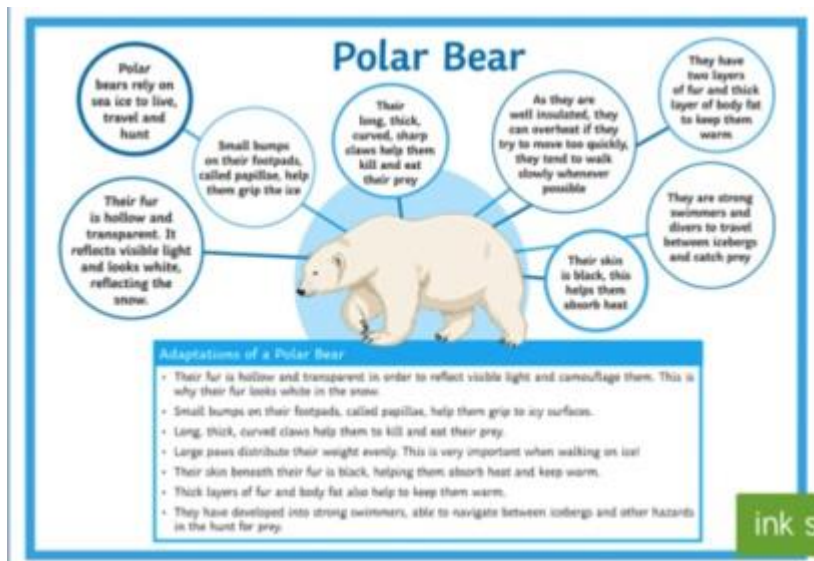


Polar bears are powerful and dangerous animals, but also beautiful. However, due to changes in the world, the sea ice they rely on is disappearing, making it much harder for them to hunt.

If this keeps happening, one day the only place to see a polar bear may be in a zoo. This would be very sad. Lots of people are working hard to try to save the polar bear...and you can help!
