What is a suffix?

A race where two people's legs are tied together.

A word that adds detail to a noun.

The sticky stuff on an envelope.

A group of letters that are added to the end of a word to change its meaning.

This week we are learning about writing words with the suffixes:



Can you read my story? When you read a word with a suffix can you write it down?

Maybe you could write the root word in one colour and the suffix in a different colour.

At the party there was great excitement and amusement. All the children stood in amazement when they saw that the entertainment was a magician. She did an assortment of tricks and she told endless jokes. We were helpless with laughter and I became breathless when I could not stop!

Spelling rule 1: add the suffixes -ment and -less to a root word.

<u>Activity 1</u>: Pick a root word, choose the correct suffix and write the word.

care pain enjoy punish treat point fear agree

Make sure it is a real word you have created!

Did you write the words correctly?

careless painless enjoyment punishment treatment pointless fearless agreement

How well did you get on?

<u>Activity 2</u>: Can you unmuddle the words? Remember they have the -ment and -less suffixes in them.



Here are the unmuddled words.

endless movement painless

spotless payment

That was tricky! How many words did you unmuddle?

Spelling rule 2 :Before you go here is a quick spelling rule to learn.

merry

becomes

merriment

If a word has more than 2 syllables and ends in -y change the -y to 'i' and add the suffix.

Lesson 5

In this lesson the children will continue to practise spelling words that include the suffixes we have learnt and practice spelling 6 golden words .

To play the suffix 'game' the children will need a dice.
