Winning Flags Craft

You Will Need:

- Rectangle of nylon fabric
- Water and acrylic paints
- Disposable plates
- Wide paintbrushes
- Tracing paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Large sponges
- Coloured duct tape
- Filled water spray bottle
- Sponge shapes template
- Wooden stick

Instructions:

- 1. Decide on a design for your flag. Think about the colours you associate with feeling positive, happy and confident. These could be the colours you choose for your 'winning' flag.
- 2. Lay the fabric out on a work surface. Spray the fabric \frown with water until it is wet.
- 3. Put each different coloured paint in a separate plate. Mix a small amount of paint with water until it is runny.
- Start by painting the background of your flag with a wide paintbrush. Use long, slow and steady movements to brush the paint on. Allow the paint to dry.





- 5. While the paint is drying, make your sponge stencils. Create your own design or trace one from the Sponge Shape Template. Cut out your stencil shape and then trace it onto a sponge.
- 6. Cut out the sponge shapes. Ask for assistance if you need help.

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7. Soak the sponges in water then squeeze out the extra water. Dip a sponge in the paint and stamp it onto the fabric. Allow to dry.

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- 8. Once the fabric is dry, paint around the shape to create a bold line. Allow this to dry.
 - Next, paint the wooden stick a colour of your choice and then leave it to dry.

10. Lastly, lay the flag on the table.

Press tape around the flag edges and tape the flag to the stick.

Now you can fly your colourful 'winning' flag!
