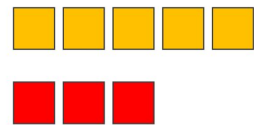
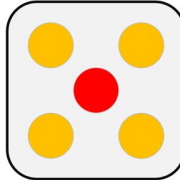


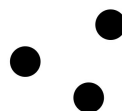
This year we chose to take part in an exciting Maths project called **Mastering Number**.

Mastering Number



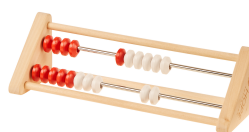
This project aims to secure firm foundations in the development of good number sense for all children from Reception through to Year 1 and Year 2. The aim over time is that children will leave KS1 with fluency in calculation and a confidence and flexibility with number.

Within the project the children will use a variety of resources and models that will help develop their sense of number. They will explore subitising and investigate how a number can be composed of two or more smaller numbers. The project also uses the engaging Numberblocks children's TV series that provides animations that support the key teaching points in the project.

How many can you see without counting?

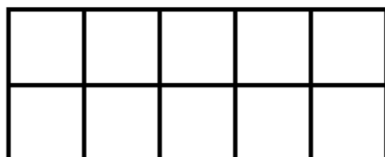

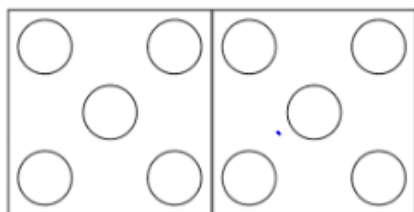
