Topic - Growing Summer 1 Week 3

Story –

- 1) Titch by Pat Hutchins read by Mrs Davison.
- 2) Oliver's Vegetables by Vivian French read by Mrs Davison.

Phonics- Can you find three things that start with the same sound as your name? e.g Claire found a can, cake and a cup.

Maths- Shape, space and measure - Measuring.

Talk to the children about height. Measure plants, objects, animals- using tape measure, lego, duplo to help demonstrate

(short/tall/shortest/tallest/

Shorter/taller)

Can you put your family into height order and take a photograph?

Who is the tallest? Who is the shortest?

Has your seed started to grow? Measure this with an adult and keep a weekly log of how tall it grows?

Understanding the World- Continue to care for your seeds. Have they started to grow? What changes can you see happening? Has a shoot appeared? How many leaves?

Physical Development

1) Ball skills -Controlling large balls – throw, catch, kick. Play throwing and catching games with your child. Try to see how many passes you can do before someone drops the ball. Count every time someone successfully catches the ball.

2) Cooking - Encourage your child to help you prepare a meal. I have seen some great examples that some of you have been doing

at home e.g making bread, cakes, chopping vegetables. This is a great opportunity to learn, not only about healthy eating, but also fine motor skills e.g cutting up apples, peeling oranges, stirring dinner etc..

Being imaginative - Have a teddy bear's picnic at home. Maybe you could make the sandwiches and a fruit salad with your Mummy or Daddy. Listen carefully and follow their instructions.
