Dear Parents

We hope you are keeping safe and well and managed to have a break over half term. This half term planning will be based on the books Handa's Surprise and Handa's Hen by Eileen Browne. The books are based in Africa so we will be focussing on learning about the culture and animals of that continent. We will use computers including Google Earth, Bug Club, Busy Things and LGFL. In maths we will focus on counting, one more, one less, finding which groups have more or less, shapes, recognising and writing numbers to 10 and positional language. In phonics we will focus on alliteration (using words that start with the same letter) and in English we will focus on vocabulary, understanding stories and mark making/writing. Please keep using Bug Club and practising name writing at home!
