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Dear Nursery Parents

Attendance and Punctuality

As your child starts to settle into the Nursery routine, I would like to take the opportunity to remind you of the school guidelines around attendance and punctuality.

Regular attendance is extremely important for your child's well being and progress in the Nursery. We realise that small children are sometimes poorly and need to stay at home, but we would like to encourage you to ensure that your children come to nursery whenever they can.

Sometimes it can be difficult to make a judgement on whether your child should come to school. Below are some general guidelines:

- If your child has a cold and/or a cough but **no** temperature, and are well in themselves, they can come to school. Please do not give Calpol before coming to nursery as this can mask a temperature.
- If your child has had sickness or/and diarrhoea, please keep them at home for **48 hours following the last bout**. This is very important to prevent infections from spreading.
- Children who have had chicken pox can return to school as soon as the spots have dried up.

In the main school, National guidelines are that all children should aim for 97% attendance. This may be more difficult to maintain for nursery age children, but we aim for an attendance level of at least 90% in the Nursery.

If your child's attendance falls below 90%, we will be writing to let you know. If their attendance is significantly lower, we may contact you to arrange a meeting. If there are any factors affecting your child's attendance, please let us know as soon as possible.

Reporting absence

If your child is absent from school for any reason, we ask that you contact the school office before 9.00 a.m. on the **first day** of absence for morning children, and before 12.00 p.m. for afternoon children. You can do this:

If your child is absent due to being unwell, please ensure that you tell us the exact nature of the illness.

Absence for other reasons

If you wish to apply for school absence for religious reasons, or for exceptional circumstances, please email the school office, giving one month's notice. **Please note that absence for holidays in term time is never authorised as per our Attendance Policy:**

Unexplained absence letters

If your child has been absent from school without explanation, you will receive a letter asking you to complete and return a reply slip letting us know why your child was away. If no reason is given, the absence will be unauthorised and this presents as a concern.

Lateness

Please could we ask that you arrive on time at the beginning of the nursery session. If you arrive after the times below you will need to go to the school office and complete a green late form before dropping off at Nursery.

- Morning drop off – 8.30 – 8.45 (**Gates open 8.25 a.m.**)
- Afternoon drop off – 12.30 – 12.45 (**Gates open 12.25 p.m.**)

Morning pick up:

- 2 & 3 year olds – 11.20 – 11.30 (**Gates open at 11.20**)

Afternoon pick up:

- 2 & 3 year olds – 3.20 - 3.30

If you are going to be late collecting your child from nursery at the end of the session for any reason, please contact the school office to let us know as soon as possible. Children can become very anxious if they are left behind, and it is important that we can reassure them that you are on your way. You will be asked to complete a Late form at the school office on collection of your child. More than three late collections could result in a fine as per our Attendance Policy (link above).

Chicken Pox Until all spots have crusted over	Conjunctivitis No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Diarrhoea & Vomiting 48 hours from last episode	Glandular Fever No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Hand, foot & mouth No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Impetigo Until lesions are crusted & healed or 48 Hours after commencing antibiotics
Measles or German Measles 4 days from onset of rash	Mumps 5 days from onset of swelling	Scabies Until after first treatment	Scarlet Fever 24 hours after commencing antibiotics	Slapped Cheek No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Whooping Cough 48 Hours after commencing antibiotics
Flu Until recovered	Head Lice No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Threadworms No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed	Tonsillitis No need to stay off but school or nursery should be informed
