The lilac band level books have no words to read but help your child develop story telling and comprehension skills through looking at pictures and talking about them. Please watch the video guide Mrs Davies has made on how to use Bug Club on Tapestry. In time, when your child starts to learn letter sounds they will move onto Pink level books with simple words.
