BugClub - Your child now has access to Bug Club. It is a brilliant website where you can access online books that have been set by your keyworker specifically for your child. The lilac band level books have no words to read but help your child develop story telling and comprehension skills through looking at pictures and talking about them. Please watch the video guide Mrs Davies has made on how to use Bug Club on Tapestry. In time, when your child starts to learn letter sounds they will move onto Pink level books with simple words. Your child will be allocated new book/s every Friday by your keyworker. If you need more books please message us on Tapestry.
