trunk

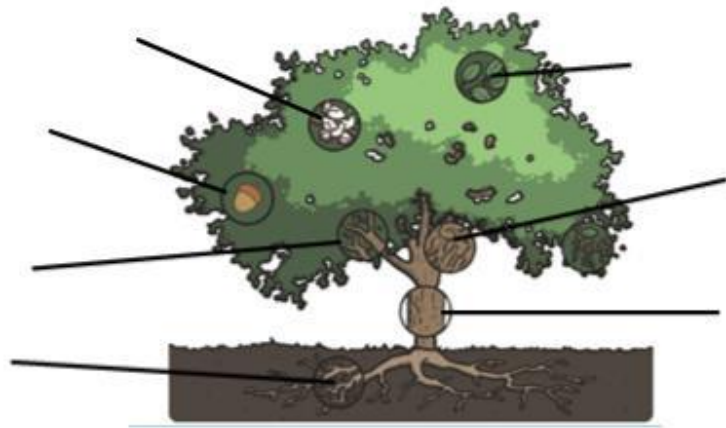

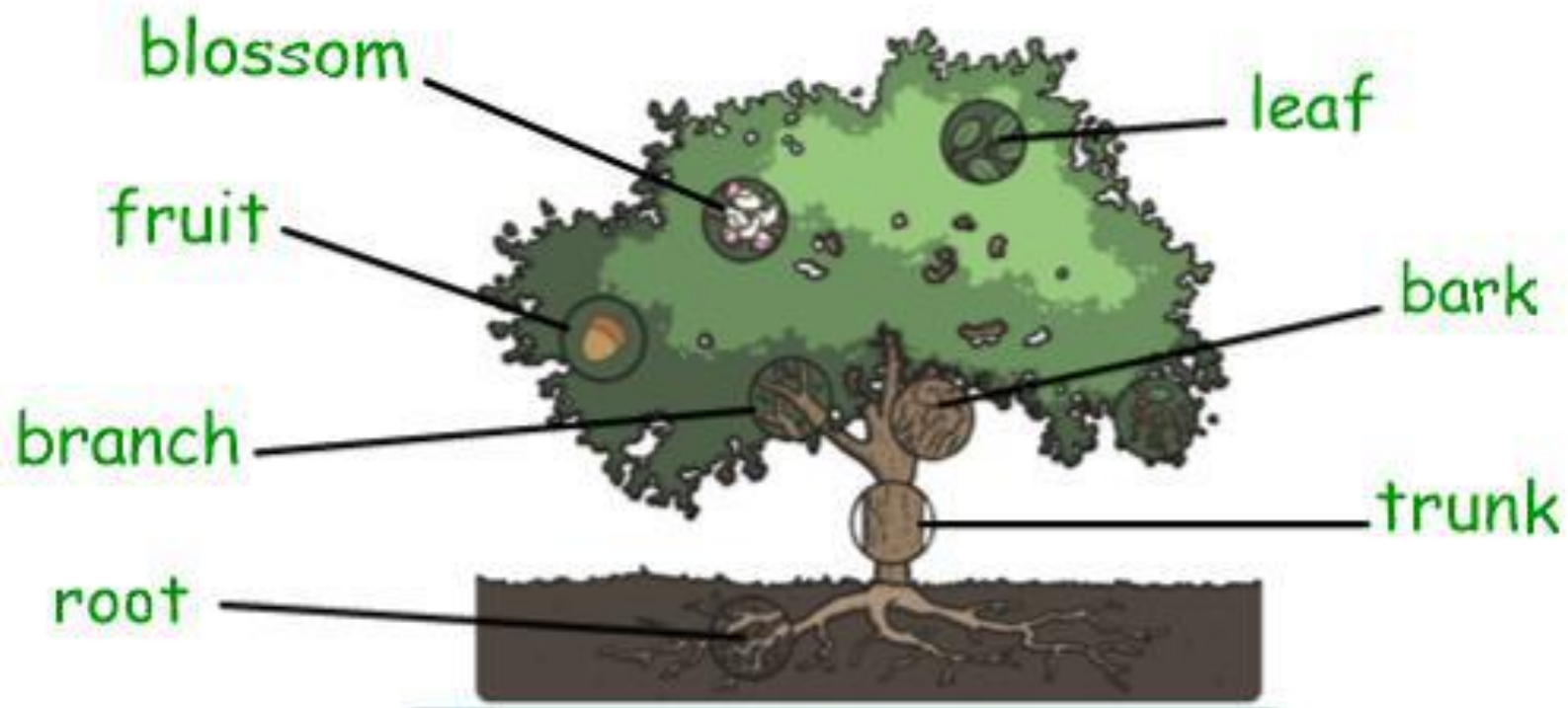

flower



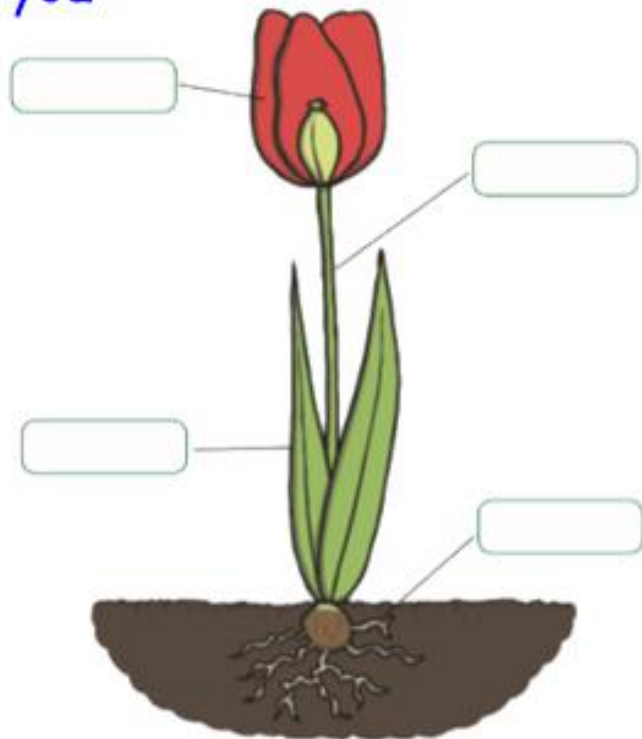
stem



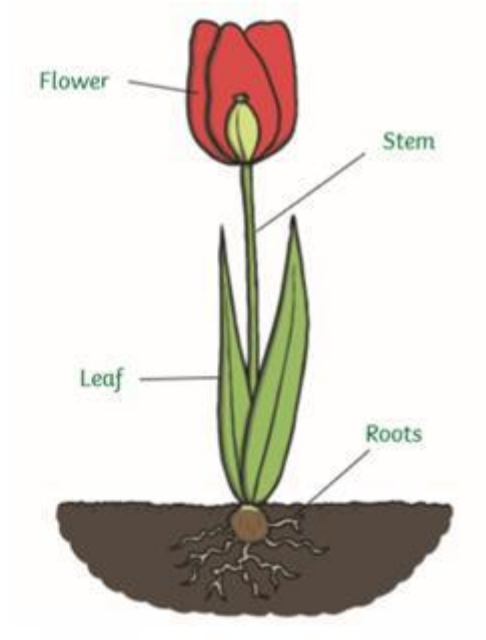
root
