There are lots of games for the children to play on this website. We are currently working on phase 5. Many games allow you to choose the phoneme to focus on.

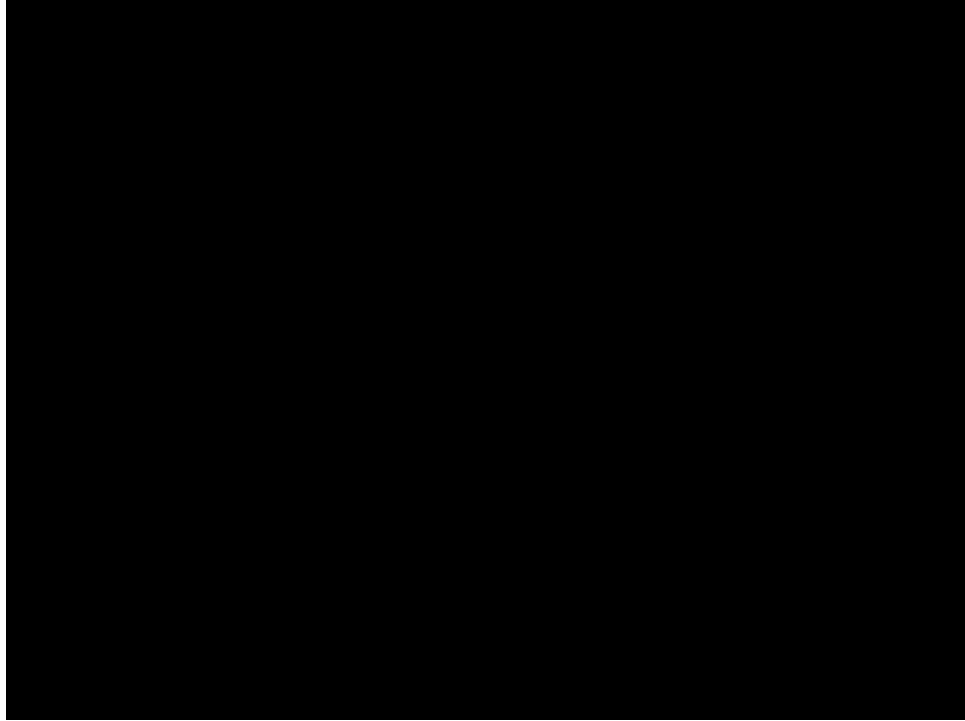
