A compound word is made of two separate words. The two words are joined together to make a new word.



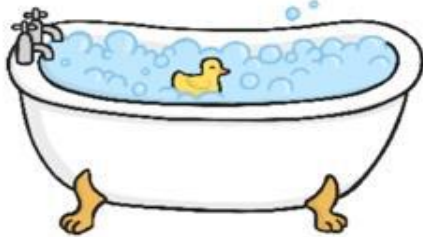

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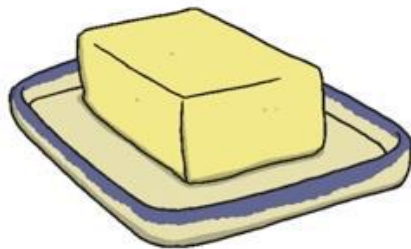


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Activity 2: Captain Compound has lost his superpowers and the compound words are no longer written correctly. Can you help him find the compound words in each sentence and write them correctly?
