- How much money will you need to buy your ingredients? Can you count out the correct coins for the shop keeper?
- -Sequence the order of how to make a cake.

Physical Development

- -Dancing at the party- create your own set of movements
- -Can you make up your own dance routine/moves to perform at the party?
