Dear Parents,

Here are some lessons for you for the week of the 6th July 2020. They cover:

- PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional Development)
- Communication and Language
- Literacy (Phonics, reading and writing)
- Maths (Numbers and Space, Shape and Measure)

As the end of the school year approaches, we will be focusing on **change**. Sequencing changing from a baby to a child, discussing changing classes and reflecting upon how the children have changed throughout reception.



PSED and Communication and Language

PSHE - Encouraging children to think about moving to the next year

- -Talk about things that will be the same and different in Year 1, compare to Reception.
- -Discuss how the children have changed since starting Reception What can you do now that you couldn't do before?
- -All about me how I have changed since starting reception and since I was a baby.
- -Can children sequence the baby as it grows? Could use photos of themselves.

Speaking and listening:

-Who am I? Give children a character, they ask question and try to guess who they are.

<u>Literacy</u>

Independent writing:

- -All about me book for new class teacher
- -Write a recipe for the cake you made at home.
- Instruction how to make a cake
- -Design a cake and label
- -Maps- Position Language (link to maths lesson)

Phonics:

- -Write a list of ingredients -see video on Tapestry
- -Write a letter to your Y1 teacher See video on Tapestry @school
- Pick a picture game See video on Tapestry @school

Reading:

- -Reading books on Bug Club (please complete the quizzes throughout the book)
- -Focus on books about starting a new class

Maths

- -Making a cake at home (order the ingredients by weight) See video on Tapestry
- Positional language See video on Tapestry@ school
- -3D shape discussion, talk about properties See video on Tapestry@ school

Physical Development

- -Workout challenges outside How many star jumps, hops etc can you do in 1 minute?
- -Physical games outside What is the time Mr wolf? Hoop/crate game Children have to find a crate/hoop to stand on, teacher or parent gradually takes them away, the floor is Lava
