

SPARK BOOK AWARDS THE 12 BOOKS OF CHRISTMAS

books and brilliant ideas for Christmas presents.




Day 1




Day 4


Day 6

to turn the pages without touching the donuts and upsetting the dinosaur.




Day 9

The sun rises and shines above us with his glorious smile.


At the end of the day, he disappears over the horizon.

But what people don't know is what the sun gets up to after he goes home . . .




Day 10
