We held our annual Science Day on Friday 10 January 2025. We loved seeing the children dressed as scientists and wearing science themed tops, and it was great to see our staff taking part too! Thank you to all the parents who joined us this morning to take part in different science activities including a STEM investigation to discover the strongest shape. A special thank you to all the parents who shared their science related jobs and hobbies.

This year the children from Nursery to Y6 took part in a whole school science experiment called Rocket Mice. The children in Nursery and Reception investigated which container would shoot the mouse the highest and KS1 investigated which material (mouse) would travel the furthest. The children



developed their science vocabulary and made simple predictions. They also learnt

how to make the test fair. In Y2, the children recorded their results on a block graph. In the afternoon, classes across the Infant and Junior schools buddied up to compare their results.
