★ The password must be at least 20 characters long, OR meet all of the following criteria

× The password must be at least 12 characters long

× The password must have at least 1 uppercase letter

× The password must have at least 1 number

× The password must have at least 1 symbol

? Must not be too easy to guess. We will check the password against a list of common passwords when it is submitted.
