Please be aware that we will not always be able to respond to google classroom as quickly as usual because we will be teaching at school during the day.

If you want to print our slides you can change them to PDFs and print more slides per page to save paper. Please remember you do not have to do **all** the work. Although there are lots of fun activities this week we would love to see as a minimum the maths quiz and the poster we are making in our English lessons (please photograph these on your phone or tablet and submit on google classroom).

English - WWF week poster (2 lessons)

This week is WWF (World Wide Fund for nature) week at school. In English we learn about the WWF and their important work. This year we are learning about hawksbill turtles and why they are endangered. There are two videos; one of Mrs Ridley reading 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley' - a cautionary tale about plastic pollution, and one of Mrs Davies reading 'One Tiny Turtle' which gives lots of turtle facts. In Lesson 2 children can then make their own posters to encourage people to save the turtles or reduce plastic pollution.

Mon/Tues children will receive the first lesson at school and then can view lesson 2 and make their posters at home. Weds/Thurs children will have both lessons at school. Home learning children should do both lessons at home. Please share posters made at home with us on google classroom.

Maths (4 lessons)

This week we will be teaching 2 lessons at school, and sending 2 lessons home for home learning. If your child is on the Monday/Tuesday rota then they will only complete lesson 1 in class this week due to the INSET day, the remainder should be completed at home. If you are staying at home, please complete all the lessons at home.

Lesson 1 (Taught in School if coming in) - Maths quiz

Lesson 2 (**Only taught in School if you are in Wednesday/Thursday**) - mental maths (recap measure, counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and quick mental maths)

Lesson 3 (Home) - recap shape (If you are staying home this week, please send your shape picture in through Google Classroom. If you are coming into school there is no need to send any work in.)

Lesson 4 (Home) - recap place value

PSHE - Welcome Back (1 lesson)

As we welcome children back to school, we will begin with a PSHE lesson that discusses changes at school and how we will keep safe. We have included it here as it has a lovely video at the end (last slide - <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2PnnFrPaRgY</u>) which has lots of suggestions about how to stay in touch with family and friends whilst we can't hug. **For all children returning to school this lesson will be delivered at school.**

Science (1 lesson)

This week in science we will be discussing what is needed for animals to survive, after some discussion we will be watching some videos to give some more information on what the essential things are for animals to survive. There is then an online quiz to try (link to bbc bitesize on slides). Following that there will be further discussion considering what might happen if any of these survival essentials were destroyed.

Art - WildArt 2020 (1 lesson)

This week we will start looking at an art competition called WildArt 2020, this competition is being held by the RSPB, links to the full details of the competition will be on the slides. Slides include information about the charity and the competition as well as some ideas about the animals and their habitats that could be the focus of the art and also the materials that the children might like to use.

Music (1 lesson)

Join in with Mrs Williamson and her family for this week's music lesson.

Handwriting, Reading, Phonics, Spelling and Grammar (5 lessons)

- 1. Reading: Books on Bug Club
- 2. Handwriting: tall letters
- 3. Spelling: starting the Year 2 common exception words.
- 4. Phonics: revising using the alternative spellings for the 'er' phoneme
- 5. Grammar: learning how to the conjunction 'because'

We would like to see that you have been Reading and playing the conjunction sentence game on Active Learn Primary please. We can check this by logging on ourselves. Resources needed - paper, pencil and your letterjoin and Active Learn Primary logins.
