

Year 1 Week 4 - commencing 22nd June Learning Overview

Thank you for your ongoing support with home learning. As in previous weeks we have planned the same learning for children in school and children at home. This is to ensure that children at home don't miss out on the curriculum we are teaching in school. However we understand that all families are working with different circumstances and have indicated what we are asking for as a minimum as well as what is optional. Please select those lessons on google classroom that work for your family and support your child's interests.



School children: The required maths and English lessons will be taught in school. **Please ensure your child is reading at home using Bug Club.** *The children attending school will receive all other lessons at school except for history, computing, music and Maths lessons 3 & 4. These additional lessons can be completed at home.*

Home learning children: **Please submit the learning from the first maths lesson (worksheet 1) as well as the English story writing on google classroom. Please ensure your child is reading at home using Bug Club.** All other lessons are optional. *However please note that the grammar lesson and the art lesson support the English story writing and children would benefit from completing these first.*

Summary of lessons - week 4:

Art - children create their own fantasy land at the top of a magical tree.

English - creative writing. The children write a description of the fantasy world they have created in the Art lesson.

Handwriting, Reading, Phonics, Spelling and Grammar (see slides for details)

2. Handwriting

Maths- This week we are learning about money. Children will learn to recognise and problem solve using coins and notes. Mental maths this week is a recap on capacity, and some arithmetic practice.

Science - Naming the parts of a flower.

Book quiz - focus on the features of Information books. We read and answer questions about a book called 'Plant Traps'.



PSHE - listening to the story 'The Jar of Happiness' and collecting/making things to put in our own jars of happiness. Please bring your own jar to school if you are coming to school!

History - have fun making a personal timeline about key events in your own life.




PE
