<u>Lesson 1 (To be done in school)</u>- We will read our new book, Supertato. We will think about superheroes and make our very own fruit and vegetable superhero!

<u>Lesson 2 (To be done at home for all children)</u>- We would like children to think about what makes a hero and to think of a key worker hero who they would like to write a letter to. We would like to encourage children to send their letter to a key worker that they know, or leave their letter on their window for a keyworker to see.

If at home full time, please submit the worksheets on place value and partitioning via google classroom. Additional activities include completing a missing number 100 square and dot-to-dot pictures up to 100.

Maths Section 2 - (all children at home) Recap of Number Bonds to 10 and 20; Recap of halves and quarters.

PSHE wBook quiz - (at school for those attending school, at home for those at home fulltime) Listen to the book read by Mrs Davies (and her cat) 'The Little Gardener' by Emily Hughs and look at the pictures on the slides. Can you answer the quiz questions?

Science (at school for those attending school, at home for those at home fulltime)
In Science this week we will be looking at what plants need to help them grow. First we will be finding out what plants need and then doing a short activity drawing these different things, there are also some links to BBC Bitesize to find out more and have a go at a quiz. After that we will read the story Grow Flower Grow!

In the next part of the lesson we will be looking at how to plant seeds to grow healthy flowers and writing clear instructions on how to do so.
