Dear Year 1

We hope you have enjoyed using your Google classrooms this week. Thank you for all the photos and videos you have sent us, especially your Panda Board games. They were amazing! Although we are delighted to see all the work you are doing please remember to **only do what you can and you do not have to do it all**. As a minimum each week there is one maths activity, one english activity and reading we need to see. This week it is a photo or picture of you halving the numbers in maths, to complete the game on 'Grammar and Spelling Bug' using -ed suffixes and to see you reading on 'Bug Club'.

English and Art

This week we would like you to create your own bear! It can be as realistic or as creative and imaginary as you would like. You can draw, paint or model your bear. You could write a description about your bear or label your picture with lots of adjectives. Your teachers have all designed their own bears! You can see videos of their ideas at the end of the English slides.

Bear Topic

This week we are learning about two bears that live mainly in North America. There are lots of fun videos to watch including Mrs Davies reading a book about them. You can play 'spot the difference'!

Science

This week we are conducting an experiment to find out what happens to a piece of fruit cut in half and left. We are encouraging children to make daily observations of their fruit experiment.

Handwriting, Reading, Phonics, Spelling and Grammar

1. Reading: Books on Bug Club
2. Handwriting: writing funny jokes for your family on Letterjoin
3. Spelling: spelling tricky words
4. Phonics: revising using the alternative spellings for the air phoneme
5. Grammar: learning how to use the suffixes -ed at the end of action words to make them in the past tense.

We would like to see that you have been Reading and playing the word ending game on Active Learn Primary please. We can check this by logging on ourselves.

Resources needed - paper, pencil and your letterjoin and Active Learn Primary logins.

Maths

This week in maths we will be looking at halving both shapes and numbers. There are lots of small optional tasks where you can have fun drawing lines over shapes to try and cut them in half or you could even draw your own shapes and ask an adult to help you cut them. We would also love to see your challenges of halving numbers, this is in lesson 3 where you will discover an easy way to half numbers. For this challenge you could use counters or any small toys or you can simply draw the counters on like we have on the slides. It is up to you! After that there are some more fun problem solving challenges to look at and some quick mental maths addition and subtraction questions. Enjoy!
