Thank you to all the adults and children for your hard work in learning the maths facts for our weekly 'fluency quiz'. Next term we are asking the children to become more fluent in solving division facts. Please keep a copy of this letter at home so that children can continually review their knowledge and develop quick recall of facts.

$6 \div 2 =$	$40 \div 5 =$	$20 \div 5 =$	$20 \div 2 =$

Every week the children will be asked to answer a selection of calculations in a time limited 'quiz'. The results of this activity will be sent home so that parents can monitor how well their children are progressing.

Here is an example of the activity children will be asked to complete every week:

$6 \div 2 =$	$10 \div 2 =$
$1 \div 5 =$	$3 \div 5 =$
$10 \div 10 =$	$3 \div 10 =$
$9 \div 5 =$	$10 \div 2 = \underline{\quad} \div 5$
$14 \div 2 =$	$20 \div 10 = \underline{\quad} \div 2$
