

Dear Parents and Carers

What a fantastic start to home learning! Thank you so much for all your support and effort. We really love seeing the children's amazing work.

We have continued the same layout for the home learning as last week. We have included a suggested timetable and included a brief description of each task. The slides provide more detail and explain the learning options. We have highlighted the tasks which are to be uploaded. This week there are 2 for maths, 2 for English and we would like you to choose a topic piece to be shared with us. Please submit work as soon as it is completed. Work can either be uploaded onto Google Classroom or Tapestry. If you submit work on Google Classroom please remember to click on 'hand in' so that we know to respond to it.

This time we have included some videos made by the Y1 teachers - we hope you find these helpful and these help to engage the children in their learning. We are also hoping it can help the children to become more independent learners.

We have also provided optional exercise books for parents to collect if they need them. These can be collected from school on Monday between 11 and 2 o'clock.

Maths

This week the children are continuing to learn about time. For some of the lessons this week we are using a resource from the White Rose Maths Hub. They provide high quality teaching videos which we feel will support the children's learning and also help them to work more independently. The videos come with designated activity sheets which are provided in the learning packis. However, in each maths lesson we suggest a second activity option that does not require parents or carers to print resources.

We have also provided daily 'Flashback 4' activities. Each Flashback 4 slide contains 4 questions that refer back to previous maths learning. These questions are designed to ensure that children revise and revisit previous skills and knowledge.

Once again, we'd like to say thank you for all the hard work from both children and adults. If you have any questions please do not hesitate in contacting your class teacher. We hope everyone has a good week.
