
Year 2 - Autumn 1 - Presentation Skills





If your child is unable to use a computer to make a presentation, they can make one using paper, using a piece of paper for each slide. Here is a suggested task that will help reinforce this learning:

- 1. Using some images found online or your own drawings, create a presentation about a topic of your own choice e.g. Animals, Toys, Space, Bears, Plants or Pirates/Explorers
- 2. For each image you include, use one slide, and write something about it this could also be text or facts found online.
- 3. Present your presentation to a family member or friend.
