

Year 2 - Presentation Skills

I can use basic computer skills.

I can organise ideas for a presentation.

I can create a simple presentation with text.

I can add and format an image.

I can reorder slides and present a presentation.

We have been learning how to make presentations on the computer. The presentation skills your child has been learning are to add new slides and change the layout and to add and format text and images. If your child is unable to use a computer to make a presentation, they can make one using paper, using a piece of paper for each slide. Here is a suggested task that will help reinforce this learning:

1. Using some images found online or your own drawings, create a presentation about a topic of your own choice - e.g. Florence Nightingale, Habitats, The Great Fire of London, Life Cycles.
2. For each image you include, use one slide, and write something about it - this could also be text or facts found online.
3. Present your presentation to a family member or friend.

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You may have applications like Microsoft PowerPoint, Apple Keynote, Google Slides (free with a gmail address) or you could use JiT through your LGFL account which the children are familiar with using at school.
